***Objectives of the program:***

- *Awareness of Tibetan root and identity*
- *Knowledge of Tibetan history and government*
- *Introduction to Tibetan Buddhism (both essence and aspects)*
- *Learn about the fundamentals of meditation and prayer*
- *Learn Tibetan language: reading, writing and conversation*
- *Learn Tibetan culture and tradition (Dance & music)*
- *Learn about Traditional Tibetan Art (Thangka painting)*
- *Cultivation of Joy and Fun: cooking, swimming and nurturing friendship*

**Registration:**

*Interested parents should fill out the application form and submit it to summer camp coordinator cum curriculum director Lobsang Tsering la by July 10<sup>th</sup> 2019.*

**Fees:**

- *Full four day participation with all field trips inclusive: \$40 per child.*
- *Day fifth (Aug 10th, Saturday) is free.*
- *Specific daily participation without field trip: \$10 per child.*
- *Specific daily participation with field trip per child \$20*
- *Specific daily participation on swimming trip: \$20 per child.*

**Parental duties:**

- *Food preparation and camp event helpers are needed throughout the summer camp program. Please commit one day for kitchen duty/clean up and one day as event helper. Please find a suitable substitute if you are personally not available. Please contact Lobsang Tsering la as soon as you know your preferred day for help.*

**Terms of Agreement:**

- *Participation in the camp is completely voluntary. TLCC will take utmost care of the participants during the camp. However, TLCC will not be responsible or liable for unforeseen circumstance such as accident or injury to participants.*
